NEGS invites community classical guitar enthusiasts, both players and listeners, to join us.

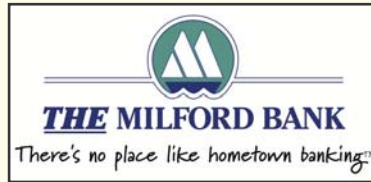

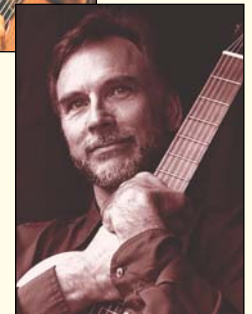
